Based on my reading of the above article, here are some of my comments:

- 1. The title of the article is too long. As far as I am concerned, the title of an article is better when concise and shorter.

 Based on my encounters with many journals, many of them limit the title to 14-15 words. This is significant for attracting more readers' curiosity from the title.
- 2. In the abstract, and also at the introduction of the article, it is mentioned that "Every day at least 149 to 400 Rohingya refugees come to Aceh...". Based on my reading of the news lately, it is too exaggerated since the influx of Rohingya refugees does not come to the Indonesian archipelago every day. So, be realistic about the real facts.
- 3. Some of the descriptions in the article are too short, and some are also only pointers which need to be broadly elaborated, such as at page 6. I also found that some sentences are written with the same words, which may reduce the quality of the sentences.
- 4. Some of the English is in good form, but some is quite poor. English should be reviewed.
