Because some of the covariates are not statically significant but you reported as statically significant associated with your outcome variable for example "Knowledge of HIV status (AOR =1.034; CI=0.428-2.500) and Multiple sexual partner (AOR =0.450; CI=0.060-3.3770)". Take a look the confidence interval it holds 1.
