Review of: "Generative Artificial Intelligence Using Machine Learning on Wireless Ad Hoc Networks"

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Overall, this is a well-written article, has satisfactory experimental results, and potential use cases in the industry.

However, I do think it can be improved in two key areas:

1. Using other techniques to benchmark: Both simpler baseline models (traditional optimization methods) and more advanced models (transformers) should be included to give the reader a perspective of how good these results actually are.
2. Adding specificity: A lot of details are left for the reader to "guess." For example, the training process is not clearly described. A more detailed explanation of BSSID should be added. Including case studies of existing uses of AI in the networks would also be beneficial.
