Notwithstanding, here are a few considerations to strengthen the paper:

- It may be useful to include the discussion guides or provide more detail on the questions asked. It would be interesting to gather more insights on the format, modality, frequency, etc., of parenting education beyond the need.
- It would be good to understand more about the parents' viewpoints, as it is presented quite generally. Did mothers and fathers agree? Parenting education for fathers is also a key area to address more specifically.
- The sample size was small and difficult to draw conclusive insights from. It could also be useful to compare samples across different settings.
- A final review of grammar and punctuation would be useful.
