"Table 4" in the Results section was created for only one data point; it is not suitable for an academic article. Please add this data to other tables or mention it in the text without tables.

An additional 2-3 sentence paragraph can be added to the Discussion section. We conducted a similar study in the first months of the pandemic in Turkey. Our article became very popular; I have no doubt that it will contribute to your article.
