It's crucial to establish the context and draw attention to the research gaps that require attention. This paper doesn't provide an ideal explanation, in my opinion.

I haven't seen the writers of this manuscript, if it employs qualitative methodologies, analyzing the data using a grounded theory, thematic, or narrative analytic approach. Internal validity is one of them (reliable data and consistent analysis). to enable a clear interpretation of the results in light of the author's conceptual framework and the surrounding context.



Few references are mentioned, particularly those from more recent, respectable publications in the same field. To strengthen the framework, it would be preferable if the author expanded by including the most recent references from reputable journals.
