Review of: "New Approach for Targeting Small Molecule Candidates for Intrinsically Disordered Proteins"

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This in-silico study identifies several promising candidates, but many of the top hits modulate broad signaling pathways, raising concerns about pharmacological selectivity and potential off-target effects; the author could discuss this aspect. Additionally, the work would benefit from mapping the identified tau-related informational frequencies to specific protein regions, which could provide mechanistic insights and guide future experimental validation.
