Well-written article, just to highlight a few factors: the turn-around time and the cost per test, which are two of the most important factors that can judge the on-ground utility of the investigations.

The introduction is well written about the utility and importance of the disease. The turn-around time could be decreased by using multiplex PCR platforms, which give results much quicker, and the cost per test can be decreased by the in-house production of the primers.

The test indicated in this article is well in line to meet the current requirements of the dreaded disease, but the things above, as mentioned, have to be kept in mind, especially in low-facility setups.
