After reviewing the manuscript, please review the following points:

- 1. The abstract also needs revision.
- 2. The introduction is short and does not mention the necessity of research and other studies.
- 3. The methodology is incomplete and ambiguous. No explanation has been given regarding the sampling method of the research location, validity and reliability of the questionnaire.
- 4. How was the data analyzed and with what software and what version?
- 5. What statistical tests were used?
- 6. Validity and reliability of the questionnaire have not been reported.
- 7. The title of the tables is not correct. The way of reporting the data in the tables is not appropriate and the standard deviation is not stated.
- 8. The discussion and conclusions are very weak and need to be substantially strengthened.
- 9. The number of references is low and not acceptable. Use more and new references.
