While the passage provides a thorough analysis of the dredging issues in the Larache region of Morocco, some omissions and shortcomings can be identified:

Lack of Quantitative Data: The text does not provide specific quantitative data on urban growth, sand demand, or the consequences of dredging. Including statistics and figures would enhance the credibility of the analysis.

Absence of Temporal References: The passage does not specify the time period to which it refers. Including a temporal reference would be helpful to contextualize the analysis over time.

Lack of Cited Sources: There are no specific references to sources used to support the arguments. Citing studies, reports, or experts would strengthen the validity of the claims.

Primarily Focused on Consequences: While the passage addresses the consequences of dredging, it could be enriched by further exploring the underlying causes of rapid urban growth and increased sand demand.

Lack of Divergent Perspectives: The text seems to adopt a predominantly critical perspective towards dredging. Including divergent opinions or contradictory viewpoints could provide a more balanced view of the issue.

Emphasis on Complexity without Specific Details: Although the text emphasizes the complexity of the situation, it does not provide sufficient details on the specific aspects that make the situation complex. Clarification would be beneficial.

No Political or Institutional Proposals: The passage focuses on practical measures at the dredging level but does not propose political or institutional solutions to address long-term structural issues.

Addressing these points would enhance the passage in terms of clarity, credibility, and relevance for readers.
