Below are the Review notes for the manuscript entitled "Determinants of Corporate Finance Performance in Africa "Insurance Market"

- 1. It is preferable in the title to use "factors affecting performance" rather than determinants of performance because the latter may be implicitly understood as obstacles that limit performance.
- 2. The abstract should mention the type of effect for each variable, whether it was positive or negative.
- 3. The abstract should mention the sample, research limitations and implications, practical benefits, and originality.
- 4. The hypothesis development section should be supported by relevant literature.
- 5. Explain the reason for using ROA to measure performance without other alternative measures of performance such as ROE and ROI.
- 6. In Figure 1 financial performance should be used instead of return on assets.
- 7. The sample size should be determined based on scientific methods, including the Steven Thompson equation
- 8. The presence of linear interaction between the independent variables should be checked and the data should be normally distributed.
