There are many **major modifications** regarding the paper which should be incorporated by the author before publication.

These have been incorporated as hereunder:

Technical comments:

- 1. The paper requires to be supplemented with scientific facts and statistics in present scenario in Indian context and in Global context.
- 2. Elaborate introduction with more comprehensive view of literature pertaining to the study.
- 3. Please refer to recent and latest research works as reference in this regard.
- 4. Add context and background to the research question.
- Methodology is very vague; should explain systematic carrying out of research work with emphasis on usage of tools, methods; their relevance and modus of operandi.
- 6. All the tables are without source or references.
- 7. The statements should be clear and crisp. Avoid too long statements.
- 8. Paper is more generalised form of discussion lacking all scientific facts, past research work in the field, description of methodology, and detailed discussion of the work.
- 9. Absence of parameters/aspects in relation with scientific approach along with absence of use of qualitative and quantitative methods adopted to collect and analyse the data.
- 10. Absence of detailed scientific discussion and results section makes it a mere generalised discussion and not research work meant for publication.
- 11. Conclusions are without scientific rationale. Please elaborate them in context to research question.
