

Review of: "Process for Implementing a Quality Management System (QMS) Adapted to Architectural Practices in Tunisia, in the Case of ISO 9001"

Comments:

The Process-based ISO system is a traditional system, whereas the outcome/performance-based system is the latest modern ISO system. The author has attempted to explain "Process for Implementing" the traditional one to the architectural firm, whereas the effort in attempting so won't offer any new insights to research-level needs.

And the reference cited, "<https://planer-am-bau.de/>," is the German version. So international readers cannot understand the terminologies explained here.

In my view, this article contains more traditional theoretical-based inputs for readers rather than research- or case study-based new concepts.

I suggest the author to get more recent certification processes in architecture-related certifications such as "PMP," "LEED," "TOGAF," "USGBC" that could attract more readers in the specified domain.

Thereby, it is not suitable for publication in its present form.
