Asut et al. conducted a study to evaluate the perceptions and attitudes regarding COVID-19 vaccination and hesitancy among attendants of a healthcare center in Northern Cyprus. This is a well-written study with a detailed methodology. I have a few minor revisions:

1. In the abstract, the authors write, "Of the total participants" - please state the count.
2. In the introduction, the authors write, **Objective:** The current study aims to investigate the vaccine uptake, intention to accept the COVID-19 vaccines, and vaccine hesitancy rates in the society of Northern Cyprus and associated factors." Please state the primary and secondary objectives separately.
3. In the results, it would be interesting and more meaningful to employ univariable and multivariable logistic regression models to evaluate the association between attitudes, perceptions, and knowledge regarding COVID-19 and its vaccination with all sociodemographic factors such as education, ethnicity, age, etc.
4. In the discussion, please add the limitations of the study.
