The research methodology lacks details regarding the profile of the population selected for the study. The details of the tools used for analysis are not mentioned clearly.

The implications of FWS for educators, students, educational institutions, and the community as a whole need to be written in detail. The recommendations should stem from the precise findings.

As part of the future scope, this paper could have included more insights into the awareness needed to promote sustainability.
