

Review of: "Neuroeconomics as an Appropriate Approach to Clarify the Economic Model: The Case of Russia"

Although the paper is devoted to one of the important approaches such as neuroeconomics, the research has not been conducted systematically and in detail. In this regard, a comprehensive study and examines the case of Russia, is very crucial.

1. The methodology of the research is not completely clear. There is no methodological approach in the research and the research mainly based on citing more similar papers. However, there is a need to research the topic using different variables. Meanwhile, the results should be evaluated with dependent, independent, control, etc. variables.
2. Literature review is weak, and there is a need to review papers that are up-to-date and directly address the topic. There is a need to group the reviewed papers into categories.
3. The Russian case is not systematically examined. The correlation between historical and modern approaches is weak. This calls into question the seriousness and accuracy of the results.
4. The results are also weak and not fully connected to the main body of the study. There is a need to systematize the results and suggestions.
