I suggest including a brief comment about the validation of the Fagerstrom Nicotine Dependence Test for the Nigerian population. Please consider that some of these tests should be validated for specific populations; in case this does not apply to your study design, explain why. Also, describe the potential bias/limitations of including smokers from a center for Smoking Cessation Clinic; I mean, since these subjects are looking for help to quit cigarette smoking, they have a preconceived idea about the harmfulness of tobacco smoking.
