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Here are some identified gaps in the study and suggestions for improvement:

-Although it is a high-level description, the method does not show domain-specific adaptations or use of case studies, which is necessary to check for practical effectiveness. The creation and integration of case studies that implement MIATT-informed assessment and learning in specific domains is encouraged. "The Adder can shed light on the problems and solutions of other domains.

-A comparison to other MIATT-based methods, as well as to traditional ATT and IATT methods on established data sets, should be performed. Such an analysis will help in highlighting the strengths, resilience, as well as the weaknesses of the MIATT methodology.
