The theoretical framework should be succinctly explained to emphasize its relevance to the study's context.

Methodology: The details are well-presented. But, it would be better if ethical considerations are also included.

Results and Discussion: The tabular presentation and its content is well-presented and easy to understand. The discussion may be further enhanced to include more literature support as well as to include the implications of the study in the Tanzanian context.
