How technology can affect our ways of relating to each other and the construction of our identities is a very interesting issue as an emerging or expanding social phenomenon. The article explores the risks that this can bring with it, supported by Baudrillard's theory. The relationship with the theory is very well developed, however the main problem I find in the essay is that there are no positionings presented that go against the idea that the author wants to delve into. I believe that the introduction of a discussion of different approaches can give greater force to the idea that the author explores.

Therefore, if it is an essay, the discussion with other positions is a fundamental aspect that the paper should incorporate in a more evident way. The introduction of references to cognitive psychology studies could help to make some of the issues raised more tangible.

In the paper there are extensive parts of the text that are not referenced and are clearly of an opinionated nature. It is advisable to take care of this aspect.
