Summary

Indian engineering institutions need appropriate educational goals to achieve excellence. Targets focus on capacity development, quality improvements and efficiency improvements that must be linked to industrial needs. In addition, these institutes need to develop strategic plans. General comments

The article is an applied research.

The article is not well structured and is not a contribution to the scientific literature. It needs to include basic elements of the scientific literature, such as a chapter dedicated to describing the research method used.

The literature used as a reference is up-to-date and relevant.

The article is technically relevant and correct, as well as the language is clear and explicit, but this does not make the paper originally submitted as an article a special scientific document. As already mentioned, the research method chapter is missing.

Improvements you could suggest on paper

The topic could be explored more appropriately by transforming the document into an eminently scientific paper
