Title & Abstract

1. Do the title and abstract cover the main aspect of the work?

- The title should be revisited. Create a title that describes the contents of the article. The title looks short but not clear.
Who do researchers want to look at for well-being and academic performance?
- Abstract needs to be revised. Abstract contents: problems, objectives, methods (design, samples, instruments, data analysis), results, and conclusions. Follow these steps in writing an abstract.
- Keywords sort by alphabet, for example: Academic Performance, Psychological Well-being, Stress, Student.

Introduction

2. Does the introduction provide background and information relevant to the study?

- The introduction still needs to be improved. In the introduction, information must be added regarding student's well-being and academic performance and what the problems so researchers are interested in studying this topic.
- In the introduction there must be a quote from previous research.
- Use the latest study literature, at least the last 5 years.

3. How important should this research be? Are there any particular cases that researchers are interested in conducting this research?

4. Are the methods clear and replicable? Do all the results presented match the methods described?

- After looking at the results and discussion in this article, it seems that this article only uses quantitative methods for this research method. This research method does not use mixed methods because there is no information on how

many respondents were taken for the qualitative study. What is the qualitative design like? Do you only use observation or FGD too?

5. The results and discussion sections must answer the research objectives/research questions. For this research, there are 6 research objectives, so the results and discussion section must answer these six objectives.

6. Information that is not related to the research objectives/research questions does not need to be submitted in this section.

Discussion

7. The discussion section should focus on discussing the research objectives or research questions.

Conclusion

8. Please improve the way of conveying the conclusions of this research. Write a research conclusion based on the results obtained in this research briefly. What are the conclusions for student's well-being and academic performance in this research?

References

9. References must be updated with the latest references, no later than the last 5 years for research articles.

10. References in this research are still very lacking, this may be due to the absence of previous research citations in the introduction.
