

Review of: "Aerococcus urinae Endocarditis: An Emerging Infectious Disease"

The Manuscript: "***Aerococcus urinae* Endocarditis: An Emerging Infectious Disease**" is a good work that presents up-to-date information on the increasing role of the rare *Aerococcus urinae* as a cause of life-threatening infections.

Only some parts of the Manuscript could be improved:

1. Some data on the virulence factors of this microorganism could be added to understand the pathogenesis of the infection.
2. Noting tests for differentiation between *A. urinae* and *Enterococcus* genus and *Streptococcus viridians* may be helpful, as this species is closely related to them, rather than to staphylococci.
3. The missing information on the antibiotic susceptibility, the pattern of the isolated *A. urinae* is not mentioned, must be completed.
4. What is the reason for switching ceftriaxone to vancomycin for the treatment of this infection?
5. Some criteria for the duration of antibiotic treatment should be added.
