- 1. Have you not done a sample size calculation? It would be good if you could describe whether the number of subjects in this study was appropriate, including the sample size calculation.
- 2. I think the analysis would be better understood by the reader if it is described in more detail, including whether or not there is a test of normality.
- 3. I think the lack of a control group is a limitation of this study. I would also like to know why it was necessary to use a single group. Please consider adding this as a limitation of the study.
- 4. There is also an explanation in the discussion section of what interventions were combined, but I think it would be better to integrate this into the description of the interventions rather than the discussion section.
