

## Review of: "A Policy Dialogue for Nutrition of Women and Adolescent Girls: Sustainable Development Goals Matters Arising"

The paper focuses on potential intersectoral actions to tackle undernutrition among women in Rwanda. However, the study only describes general concepts in the field of nutrition and synthesizes prevalence and costs associated with undernutrition in Rwanda from other studies, followed by recommendations on public policies. The text does not include proper citations to the references within the paragraphs, and there is a lack of information on public policies for health and nutrition in the country. It would be interesting to build a link between the prevalence and costs of undernutrition among women in relation to the call to action described in the study, organizing the broad themes and sub-components according to sectors to identify the intersectoral actions proposed at the beginning of the text.
