Generally, the paper is quite good. A couple of things I would like to improve. Firstly, regarding the title.

Reading through the paper, I believe it is not about the impact of sustainability disclosure on financial

performance. The dependent variable is sustainability disclosure, not firm performance. A firm's

profitability is included as one of the determinants or explanatory variables. I suggest the title be

adjusted to reflect the content of the paper. Perhaps, "The effect of firm financial characteristics on

sustainability disclosure". This title will cover your IVs, which are leverage, liquidity, as well as

profitability, and their effect on sustainability disclosures.

The theoretical aspects and justification of the method used are well documented. If possible, publish the

results for internal consistency and reliability (Cronbach's alpha) for the index used for your

sustainability disclosure. These results will help readers understand the reliability/internal consistency of

the items used in the index that were actually measuring/testing the same underlying construct.

Other than that, I believe this is a well-written paper.
