Discussion- More evidence from recent studies may be added.

References- Both in-text and references in the end may be cited according to the Vancouver style or journal guidelines.

Conclusion- The author may add a few lines to conclude his research.

General comments- The author has chosen an important subject of reasons for relapse. The paper needs a few refinements as some findings are repeated; the author may cut down the tables by combining the variables affecting relapse. Multiple regression can be used to state the results.

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
