Overall, this article is valuable; it has the feature to contribute to science. However, there are several aspects that can be improved and complemented to further improve its quality:

1. In a quantitative research study, the hypotheses must be given. Hypotheses are not given in the study. Because in qualitative or quantitative research, the starting point is the problem and sub-problems or hypotheses. Additionally, the findings and results section should be created within these hypotheses. What and why we are researching is very important.
2. It is most appropriate to include the results of statistical analysis using data analysis methods (mean/SD and MANOVA) in the summary section. Also, explain the results of the nine methodologies mentioned in the title. Hypotheses are mentioned in the findings. On what basis was this association made?
3. Many previous studies are mentioned in the introduction section. However, the conceptual gap between the current study and previous ones remains unclear, highlighting the importance of conducting this research.
4. In the literature review section, existing supporting research data consistent with the findings of this study needs to be more comprehensive and robust.
5. The results obtained must be supported by a comprehensive discussion in terms of hypotheses. This situation is very important.
6. At the end of the study, it would be good if important suggestions and recommendations were given to shed light on the researchers.
