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The article is a very generic one. It includes a description of several different healthcare environments but no approach from an architecture and engineering point of view. It seems like a kind of literature review but not a systematic one. The authors should enlighten the air contamination in healthcare facilities. This subject became crucial since the pandemic.

If the article's goal is a very robust systematic literature review, it should have improvements. If the article is based on research evidence, it must also be clear about the goals, the methodological procedures, diagnoses, and recommendations. This second possibility must strongly take into consideration air contamination (heating, cooling versus natural ventilation) and how to measure this aspect towards better environments, spaces, and connections between each other.
