It could be better to propose an algorithm for diagnosis and, especially, for the right approach to sepsis therapy, and some tips and tricks that can help in medical practice.

It is a short review that shows us just a short story of how difficult sepsis management can be. Maybe this can be the foundation for a systematic review with statistical analysis that can offer much more knowledge.
