I have read this manuscript entitled "Government expenditure and economic growth: evidence from the critical sectors in an emerging economy"." Several points in this paper, in my opinion, should be reviewed:

First, the abstract contains unnecessary details, whereas the authors only need to present the problem, method of analysis, and main findings briefly.

Second, the novel points and added value of the current paper must be presented in the introduction, while the shortcomings and knowledge gaps in previous studies must be thoroughly discussed at the end of the literature review.

Third, the authors did not explain how and why they chose the studied variables and/or the study model.

Fourth, the conclusion should be reviewed; it should summarize the paper's objective and main results, recommendations and suggested policies, and study limitations.

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
