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Language must be crisp, with the simple past instead of the past participle tense. The abstract must be brief, with Background, Aim, Study Design, Result, and Discussion. More introduction must be on Asbestoses and Mesothelioma. The Methodology section must be restricted to the study design the authors employed. The Discussion section would benefit from comparing the statistical results (Sample size and Point-estimators of demographic and other variables) of the present study with those of other previous and contemporary studies.
