- 1. Compared with the specific issues that the authors wants to study, the literature review in this article is poorly targeted and does not focus enough on the research issues to be studied. This requires the authors to make further adjustments and improvements.
- 2. The title of the article is "Benefit distribution and stability analysis of enterprise digital servitization ecosystem/DSE...", but the article lacks analysis and discussion of the complete structure of DSE. "This paper discusses the benefit-maximization decisions of manufacturer, service provider and data provider, which are affected by relevant correction factors when they build a DSE." Is this DSE structure setting complete? Is it typical in practice? How well does it fit into the practice domain? All these should be supplemented with analysis and explanation in the article.
- 3. Before proposing figure 1 (Benefit distribution framework of DSE enterprises), the article lacked sufficient and necessary rationale support and a logical and rigorous analysis process. This makes its rationality and comparative progress unclear. It is recommended that the author further enhance this part to improve the practical value of this article.
- 4. The "management insights" mentioned at the end of the article are not highly targeted and operable compared to the practical situation/problems/causes of practice, and do not indicate whether their effects are verifiable.
- 5. Additionally, in the abstract section, "Digital servitization ecosystem (DES) is a cooperative...", "DES" should be adjusted to "DSE".
