I would only add some comments to be better.

- 1. You need to have more clarified definitions, as there are slight difference between some concepts (e.g. CSR ESG).
- 2. CSP is not a dimension..
- 3. p.4 "The case for corporate...Le, 2022)." needs to be rephrased to make sense.
- 4. p.5 "Corporate social performance...society". Poor definition. Needs to be more comprehensive.
- 5. p.5 "Thus...practice." This period has expressive and syntactical errors. Rephrase.
- 6. p.5 encampuses → encompasses maybe?
- 7. CSP has been widely used interchangeably with other similar (?) terms (Sustainable competitiveness, business performance, sustainability performance, orgaizational performance). It seems sustainability performance to fit better.
- 8. p. 6 & 7 "components/types of CSR"? You mean dimension maybe..
- 9. p.9 "Based...charitable" unclear.
- 10. So many abbreviations used. CR, CS, CT should be written in full in some cases like p.10 above the Figure 1.
- 11. Descriptive demographic information: smaller section, less tables (all-in-one table).
- 12. Data purification: smaller section, less tables
- 13. p. 25-26 You need to refer to the Hypotheses written in full not only H1, H2 etc.
- 14. Discussion and conclusions: restructure the whole paragraph. Maybe last sentence needs to be first.
- 15. ECR, ENR, and ETR direct relationship with PHR results: The intererpretation of the results does not make sense. It needs to be more comprehensive. Numbers are not enough to understand...
- 16. Conclusion: Very brief conclusion. At least two more paragraphs should be added (one in the beginning and another one in the end). Last paragraph is quite puzzling, needs to be rephrased.
- 17. You ought to make an appendix. One for the tables/figures and one for the appreviations.
