The observations below do not disqualify the paper, as it generally follows the scholar template.

The first paragraph, "In order to have a more detailed description,..." has more to do with the objective of the present research. Thus, it would fit better as the penultimate paragraph of INTRODUCTION. So, this section would start by describing the background and the questions, preparing the terrain for the objectives.

The text states that the selected reports came from previous publications. However, it would be helpful to specify how authors from 2000 to 2021 recruited experimenters for publication. Would they be, for example, reports of exceptional cases from the authors' professional experience?

For the sake of scientific advancement, it is convenient to provide a paragraph on the limitations of the present study and suggested guidelines for future studies.
