- 1. In the introduction, the term "hydrology" is repeated. Just check it, please.
- 2. In the Landhazard section, check the term "landslide rick"; what does it mean?
- 3. In the Fig. 2 title, check the term "landslide hard" or so for its correctness.
- 4. Kindly acknowledge earlier work generously reported by the various authors by citing them.
- 5. While explaining Fig. 3, in the text the term "geological" or so is repeated.
- 6. Try to analyze the work presented therein or supplement it with your own work or so.
- 7. Try to improve the English language for its flow, grammar, and spellings, etc.

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
