## Use of Digital Platforms Among University Students: A Systematic Literature Review

1. The study clearly articulated the statements of the problem and the methodology.
2. It has a comprehensive review of related literatures.
3. Transfer PRISMA results and Figure 1 as part of the presentation of findings.
4. Include a matrix of the summaries of literatures included in the systematic review.
5. Revisit themes under "challenges" (RQ2) if these can be stated as challenges, e.g., "pedagogical hindrances" instead of just stating "internet accessibility".
6. Include in the presentation of the themes which studies support these themes, like what was done in the theme exemplifying RQ3.
7. Revise the conclusion to present it as a conclusion rather than a summary of findings.
