Use of Digital Platforms Among University Students: A Systematic Literature Review

- 1. The study clearly articulated the statements of the problem and the methodology.
- 2. It has a comprehensive review of related literatures.
- 3. Transfer PRISMA results and Figure 1 as part of the presentation of findings.
- 4. Include a matrix of the summaries of literatures included in the systematic review.
- 5. Revisit themes under "challenges" (RQ2) if these can be stated as challenges, e.g., "pedagogical hindrances" instead of just stating "internet accessibility".
- 6. Include in the presentation of the themes which studies support these themes, like what was done in the theme exemplifying RQ3.
- 7. Revise the conclusion to present it as a conclusion rather than a summary of findings.

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
