

## Review of: "Switching Away From Smoking and Reduction in Cigarette Consumption among US Adult Purchasers of the JUUL System across 24 Months Including Diverse Subpopulations Disproportionately Affected by Cigarette Smoking"

Insightful and well-written article about tobacco use patterns among JUUL purchasers over a two-year follow-up period. The large sample size, longer follow-up period, as well as leveraging a population of purchasers (rather than individuals new to the product and incentivized to use it) are positive points. While the JUUL system has received a significant amount of public criticism for varied reasons, the results from this study indicate that JUUL use may play a role in smoking reduction and cessation even among vulnerable populations.
