- 4. In table1 please cite the sources where you take it
- 5. You take images questioned in july2017-aguest20222, does the season have no impact on NDVI value? As NDVI is related to the presence of water and greenness, taking wet season images may lead to wrong conclusions. Please be sure.
- 6. In the discussion section compare the results with previous similar works considering the benefits and gaps of the GEE platform for processing satellite products
