Literature Review	On Pages 3 and 4, Only two paragraphs have enough information with good citations to strengthen the manuscript.
	The sampled respondents were 444 garment workers. I have not seen the Research Design for this research. Having read the whole manuscript, this research collected data from both Quantitative and Qualitative methods. So, the research design here is that the mixed method approach of the research design was employed, which was completely missed in the manuscript. I have seen that around 10 personal communications like Citations.
Methodology	The authors have missed the part of the Qualitative data collection that was not addressed in the study. They collected the



	Qualitative data that was interpreted on pages 13 and 14.
	The authors want to mention that Personal Communications, 2018 like Citations. Please remove this information from the manuscript. Rather they can mention like Cases were interviewed in different factories.
Material and Methods	Multiple Linear Regression analysis was used to identify the significant results of the given variables to labour unrest like Accomodation fees and Motivation. The bolded numbers are significant variables in Tables 2, 3, 4 and 5. All these Explanatory Variables were analyzed. This is my suggestion that I feel that the workers' Job Satisfaction, Perception and Attitude were missed in the research that could have been measured through 5 points Likert Scale.
