3	Introduction	Literature Review	The research did not state the number/statistic for dilapidated HEIs to strengthen the research problem. If this is not available, the best way to start the research is by identifying those numbers (if possible). There are several ways to achieve this using the positivist approach: 1. Initially conducting a survey by HEIs as the unit of analysis – just to have the numbers, or 2. Using a similar closed-ended questionnaire script (primary) to get feedback – adding one more question towards the respondent from HEIs.
