- d. The datasets that have been used in the research experiments.
- e. The general results that you have obtained.
- 3. Reasoning in different parts of the proposed framework is lacking. The reasons behind the different parts of the proposal should be clearly stated.
- 4. Remove the old references. It would be better to cite more related articles, especially from the last two years.

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
