This is an interesting topic as ABC group's business continuity based on uncertainty Analysis is carried out by the respected authors. However, the manuscript has some issues requiring the following modifications:

- 1- Abstract should have one sentence per each: context and background, motivation, hypothesis, methods, results, conclusions. While the author presents the Abstract, answer the questions carefully: What problem did you study and why is it important? What methods did you use? What were your main results? And what conclusions can you draw from your results? Please make your abstract with more specific and quantitative results while it suits broader audiences.
- 2- The current Introduction should be further improved. It seems its impacts on the existing literature is limited. Or at least, the contribution is not articulated. A good one includes at least four aspects: motivation/background, literature review, aim and contribution, and the organization of the remains of the study.
- 3- Conclusion, Current limitations, future scope, scalability issues, and some other useful information should be addressed in the Conclusion section.
- 4- Please include graphical representation about the obtained results to provide a clear perception regarding the proposed study.
- 5- There are some grammatical mistakes throughout the manuscript. Please proofread the entire manuscript to improve English level of the paper.
