This article emphasizes the potential for further application of network neuroscience in psychiatric disorders such as PTSD, which should focus on continuous measurement of symptom expression and intensity considering the heterogeneity of mental illness. I agree with this viewpoint that the further application of network neuroscience and network models in continuous clinical symptoms is of great significance at present.

Although the viewpoint of this article is interesting, there are still some issues that need improvement:

1. In paragraph 6, the article discussed the heterogeneity of mental illness, but the performance of the network model in solving the heterogeneity problem of mental disorders such as PTSD was not reflected.
