For "Abstract section"; Authors are suggested to remove "e.g." from the manuscript and from sentence like "Variables of climate (e.g., short-to-long term climate-related stressors) and crime types also show non-linear association".

For "Introduction section"; the Authors are suggested to revise this section due to scanty references. Hence, this section requires more and recent literature citations.

The Authors are suggested to use numbering for the headings and sub-headings for proper arrangement/clarification. Authors are suggested to check the manuscript for grammatical errors.

For "Validation and Discussion section"; more recent literatures should be cited to validate the study findings.

For "Reference section"; Authors are suggested to follow the paper referencing guideline.
