

Review of: "[Commentary] Insulin Sensitizers as Anti-Aging Agents: Exploring the Role of Albumin and its Implications for Healthy Aging"

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The review explores the interactive role of insulin and albumin in the process of aging. The commentary does not go in a particular flow. There are some passages which do not make clear sense. For example, the sentence "Samples containing native insulin or its fragments exhibited the formation of amyloid structures, while HSA complexes displayed distinct secondary structures" does not convey that whether the aggregation of insulin is prevented in the presence of HSA. There are repeated phrases with similar meanings in the commentary: albumin, a major plasma protein; Insulin, a hormone crucial for glucose regulation. It is not clear whether insulin shows a similar kind of affinity towards albumin like degludec and GLP-1 analogs?
