Methods should be clarified: how were data extracted? Which data were extracted from newspaper reports?

The results section should be detailed: total number of patients, age (mean and range), gender, involved eye, type of ocular injury (corneal, scleral, corneoscleral, foreign body, ...), type of surgery, initial and final visual acuity, complications (cataract, retinal detachment, intravitreal hemorrhage, hyphema, glaucoma, phtisis bulbi ...), follow-up (mean, range), ...

Tables summarizing demographic data, clinical findings, and complications will be very useful.

Figure 1 should be included in the results section. Did informed consent be obtained from the patient whose photo was illustrated in figure 1?

Results of the study should be discussed in the discussion section.

Limitations of the study should be discussed at the end of the discussion section.
