Add data about: actual share of renewable energy, energy policies, public transportation, waste management, recycling & reusing, green initiatives, economic growth, social equity.
- 3. In case study 2- India: please add actual data to support your statements and use national/Asian databases.
 Moreover, please make sure you document with suitable, up-to-date information all your statements (please, add up-to-date references). Add data about: economic growth, air pollution, water pollution, CO2 emissions, share of renewable energy, policy initiatives (with clear references about each initiative), investments in green technologies.
- 4. Make sure you contrast the two countries and point out the lessons which can be learned from Sweden which can be applied to the specificity of India.
- 5. Please, make sure you cite within the text all the references.
