The text is superficial and does not add any new content to existing knowledge. To be conclusive, the review should be a meta-analysis or systematic review.

Minor comments:

In the introduction, the term hippocampus proper should be explained.

In the introduction, the term "rostrocaudally" must be removed from the sentence: "The hippocampus can be divided into head, body, and tail rostrocaudal."

Anatomical terminology must be corrected in the entire manuscript. Proper anatomical terms should replace terms such as "rostral" and "caudal" linked to animal anatomy. Rostral (or cranial) means towards the head-end of the body. It is commonly used interchangeably with the term 'superior' when the body is in its anatomical position. Caudal means towards the tail or away from the head-end of the body. It is commonly used interchangeably with the term 'inferior' when the body is in its anatomical position.
